



10 Penalties & Technical Violations












- Penalties assessed to coaches and/or wrestlers.
- The point progression for penalties for wrestlers during a match are as follows:
 - First infraction = 1 point to opponent
 - Second Infraction = 1 point to opponent
 - Third Infraction = 2 points to opponent
 - Fourth infraction = Contestant disqualified
- "One One Two DQ"







- Penalty points are cumulative throughout the entire match regard less of the penalty reason.
- Exceptions include:
 - cautions for false starts,
 - incorrect starting positions, and
 - first warning for stalling.







All defined *Illegal holds and Maneuvers* and follow the penalty point progression.

• All *Technical Violations* follow the penalty point progression.

- Unnecessary Roughness is any physical act that occurs during wrestling and exceeds normal aggressiveness.
 - forceful cross face,
 - -elbow to the back of the head etc.
- Continued acts of Unnecessary Roughness may be considered Flagrant Misconduct.
- Unnecessary Roughness follows regular penalty point progression.







- Unsportsmanlike Conduct is an act that may include physical or nonphysical acts before, during or after the match.
 - Shoving, swearing, taunting, throwing ear guards, repeatedly dropping to one knee to break locked hands, or dropping shoulder straps down while still on the mat.





- Continued acts of *Unsportsmanlike*Conduct may be considered *Flagrant*Misconduct.
- Unsportsmanlike Conduct during the match follows the regular penalty point progression.
- Unsportsmanlike Conduct of contestants, coaches, or other team personnel, not during the match, is as sessed a;
 - -1 team point deduction for the first infraction, and
 - 2 team point deduction and removal from the premises for the remainder of the event.








- Flagrant Misconduct is defined as any act serious enough to remove the offender from the premises.
- These acts may occur prior to, during, or after a match.
- The use of tobacco products would warrant such action.





- Flagrant Misconduct carries the following penalties:
 - Coaches and contestants are removed from the premises and assessed a 3 team point deduction.
 - Removal is for the remainder of the event, as well as further action as defined by OHSAA.
 - Coaches are fined and
 - Must attend an on-line class








- False Starts and Incorrect Starting
 Positions both include 2 cautions prior
 to there being a 1 point penalty for
 each additional infraction.
- False Starts and Incorrect Starting
 Position points are cumulative through the match.





Technical Violations

- Technical Violations are non-injury infractions listed below and follow the regular penalty chart point sequence:
 - Going out of the wrestling area or fleeing the mat
 - Grasping clothing, which includes headgear
 - Locking hands
 - Leaving the wrestling area without permission
 - Reporting to the scorers' table not ready to wrestle or not properly equipped to wrestle
